- ▶ Abstract submission is open to registered candidates only

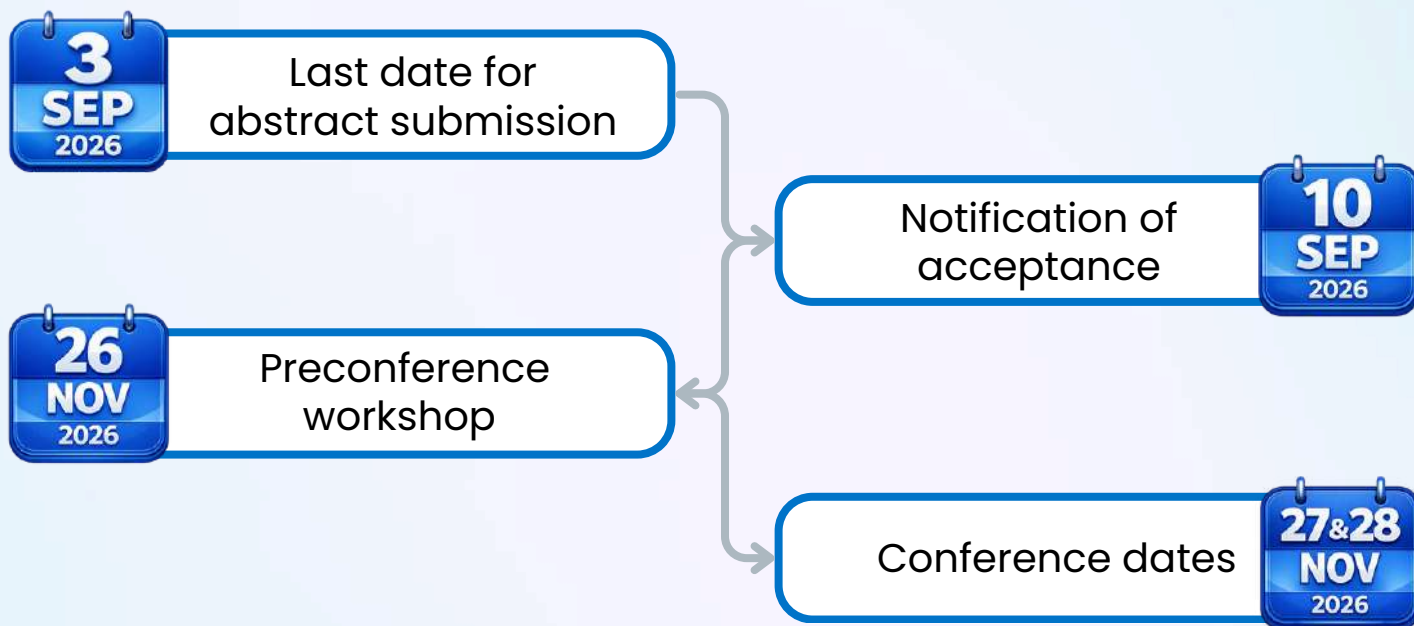

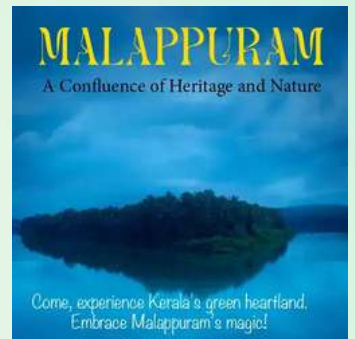


Kozhikode
