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

## **DAY 1 – 13<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2025**

### **PRE CONFERENCE WORKSHOP**

Nurse Researchers Society for Innovations in collaboration with Panna Dhai Maa Subharti Nursing College organized the Pre-Conference Workshop as part of the 29th Annual National Conference of NRSI on the theme “**Empowering Nurse Researchers: PRISMA for Systematic Review**” on 13th November 2025.



## **DAY 2 – 14<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2025**

### **1<sup>st</sup> DAY CONFERENCE**

The Nurse Researcher Society for Innovation (NRSI), in collaboration with Panna Dhai Maa Subharti Nursing College, organized the 29th Annual National Conference on the theme “Emerging Trends in Nursing Research” on 14th and 15th November at the Maharani Laxmi Bai Auditorium, SVSU..

The conference commenced with the **First Plenary Session** on “Emerging Trends in Nursing Research Methodologies.” The distinguished Resource Persons included Dr. Assuma Beevi, Director, Aster MIMS Academy, Kerala and President, NRSI, who delivered an insightful talk on Multidisciplinary Research; Dr. Anil Sharma, Principal, Manikala Toawala College of Nursing, Charusat University and Vice President, NRSI, who presented on Implementation Research; and Dr. Priyanka Bansal, Chief Academic Officer, NNL ONE (Nursing Next), New Delhi, who spoke on the Delphi Technique.
